This year, four deserving Arrowmen were selected to receive the service award.

The first recipient was Anthony Johnson, the outgoing Section Chief. Anthony has served Scouting diligently since he was a Cub Scout, but in recent years, he is known for his work as a seasoned summer camp

staffer, a valuable lodge officer, and his leadership in the section.

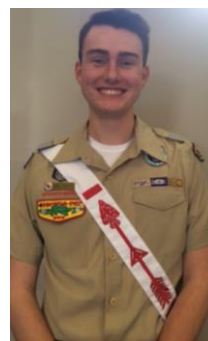
